



DABOR Committee Volunteer Application

Each year, the Dearborn Area Board of REALTORS® is challenged to bring its membership the services, and information they want and need. This is where your help is needed. We are looking for dedicated members to help with our committees. It is our focus to have each office represented in our committee so that all offices have a say on how your board is operating and to be the liaisons from DABOR to your office.

Finance Committee is responsible for reviewing the budget and financial policies of the Association. The Committee recommends policies for the investment of funds and The committee shall be responsible for setting the annual budget and meet to oversee the association budget. Meets 1 or 2 times a year.

Government Affairs/ RPAC Committee's goal is to encourage members' awareness and participation in legislative and political activities. Some of the activities include conducting candidate interviews at local and state levels, making recommendations for support and endorsement, raising funds and increasing awareness about the REALTORS® Political Action Committee (RPAC), and monitoring legislative issues which have a potential affect on the real estate business and private property rights. Meets as needed.

Membership Services' The Committee promotes an awareness of Board functions to members to help improve participation, and enhance the REALTOR® image in the community. The Committees goals also include REALTOR® advocacy initiatives as dictated by NAR. This is accomplished by supporting the public awareness campaign through local media, and conducting a variety of events and activities through Task Forces. Meets approx. 3 times a year (By joining this committee, you can select one or more events to participate in).

Grievance Committee Selected members serve to review requests for arbitration (commission disputes) and to determine the possibility of member violations of the Code of Ethics. This committee ensures that all complaints are processed in an expedient manner. There is special training provided for all Grievance Committee members which ensures that all members are qualified to deliberate these matters. Meets as needed. Prerequisite: Three (3) years as a Dearborn Area Board of REALTORS® member (Primary or Secondary). *Requires attendance at yearly training.

Professional Standards Committee (appointed) is responsible for conducting Professional Standards Hearings. Meets as needed. *Requires attendance at yearly training.
